OLD BUSINESS AND REPORTS:

1. Meeting called to order by president Francie Angwin at 1:04 p.m.
2. Attendance-13
3. Approval of January 19 meeting minutes: Moved by Sandy Hughes, seconded by Cheryl Faconti, approved.
4. Membership-Gail Spencer: 16 dues checks have been collected in the last 10 days. Our membership is 65
5. Treasurer's report-Janice Batchelder: Current balance is \$31,176.02
6. Program- Francie for Sylvia Evans: MARCH 13-14—Thursday we'll meet at GAC to prepare materials for microwave bowls, tortilla warmers, aprons.. etc. Friday: Guild Meeting and make items for sale; APRIL: 17-18: Dee Goodrich will do a "One Block Wonder" workshop. Cost will be \$10, payable to Dee then. This will only be open to Guild members, so no sign-up through GAC. She also advised that most guilds do this format to increase the number of quilts on display. The challenge quilts are a smaller display within the larger show.
