There are currently 21 enrolled for the 2015 Retreat. We would like to have 25, so there are some spaces available if you are still interested in attending.

If you haven't gone before, consider doing so. It is a great time of working, creating, eating, and laughing.

The fee for the retreat is \$150.00 payable to PPQG to cover our workroom expenses and meals. The location is Dry Creek Inn Best Western in Healdsburg (800-222-5784 or 707-433-0300). Cost for the room is your direct responsibility. Regular rooms are \$66.00 per night with two queen beds. The special rooms are \$118.10 per night with one king bed, fireplace, etc. We arrive on Monday, February 2, and leave on Thursday, February 5. Hotel rooms need to be reserved NOW. These reduced rates expire on January 2.

Lunches are provided, as are two dinners. One night we will be on our own for dinner. A hot breakfast is provided by the hotel.

Typically, people at retreat get a lot of sewing done, get a lot of inspiration from other people for new projects, make new friends or deepen existing friendships, get help/feedback with a current project, and have a lot of fun. We have a Happy Hour every evening at 5:00 where you can bring a snack food and a beverage of choice to share.
